*There are some things you can do to protect yourself, family and friends from getting sick.*

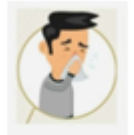
Wash your hands often and for at least 20 seconds

after using the toilet

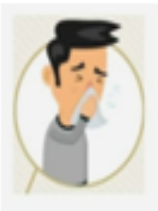


after sneezing
