

Making a pattern for wallpaper

Art with Madeleine



You will need:

2 different leaves, pencil, paper, colours

Optional: Permanent marker, sponge, food colouring,



Find 2 leaves and get a pencil and paper



Draw around one of the leaves



Draw around the second leaf next to the first one



Continue until all the paper is full



Go over your pattern with a pen or permanent marker



If you have a printer at home you can use it to make copies of your drawing



Use a sponge to wet the paper with water - put some plastic on the table first!



Use a brush to add drops of food colouring



Add as much colour and detail as you like!

You could then colour copy it and join together to make a large piece of wallpaper!

- Look at the picture, **what can you see?**
- What **shapes** can you see?
- Are the brush strokes made with the same **size paintbrush**? Have they been made slowly or quickly.

Your Turn

You will need:

- A piece newspaper
- Paint
- Paint brushes
- Sponges
- Water pot

Make an painting in the style of Irvin.
Look at the layout of the newspaper. Can you see the columns and blocks of writing? See how the photographs are square and oblong? You will paint on top of the shapes.
Choose **two colours**. Fill an area of newspaper using the lightest colour.
Then add a few drops of the darker colour and mix together.
Paint another area and repeat this process until you cover the whole sheet.
This is the **background**.
Use different size brushes, sponges and patterns.



Make a rainbow cloud



You need:

Strips of coloured paper

White A4 paper

Glue

Marker pen

Scissors

String or wool

Step 1

With each colour make a paper chain. Make 7 paper chains of different colours. If you don't have rainbow colours, this is ok.



Step 2

On the white paper or card, draw a cloud with a smiley face and cut it out.



Step 3

Make a hole with a hole punch in the top of the cloud and thread your string or wool to make a loop.



Step 4

Glue each paper chain to the back of the cloud



Step 5

Hang in the window for all to see.

Kandinsky Heart Art Project: Materials

White Card Stock

Black Crayon or Oil Pastel

Watercolour Palette

Black Paint

Step 1

Draw a heart on A4 paper. Make sure your heart fills the paper.



Step 2

Using a black crayon or black pen, fill the heart with different size circles. Fill as much space as possible.



Step 3

Paint or colour the circles in. You can colour them fully or make patterns in them.



Step 4

Paint or colour any leftover white areas with black.





Make Your Spring Flower Art Collage With:

- Scissors
- Magazines/catalogs
- Pencil for drawing the outline
- Glue stick
- Stock paper

Step 1

Draw the flower outline on paper.



Step 2

Choose your colours then find them in magazines. Make small piles of the colours you've collected. Make sure they are old magazines.



Step 3

Glue each piece of colour into place on the petals.
