

## Making a Pattern using Fruit and Vegetables

We are going to make a pattern using these things

| <p>A sheet of paper and a candle or a white wax crayon</p>                         | <p>Some cold tea – no milk!</p>   | <p>A strawberry and spinach – or leaves and berries from the garden</p>              |

You could also use other leaves and fruit

First draw with the candle or wax crayon on the paper – you could get a grown up to light the candle and drip the wax on the paper



Then use a sponge to put cold tea on top of your drawing – where the wax is should stay white



When it is covered it should look a bit like this





Next get your leaves and rub them on the paper – you can use the sponge to get the bits off the paper



Then use a strawberry or something similar to make spots on the pattern
































Carry on until you like the colours and pattern – here is mine!






























Have fun and try different foods to make more colours!

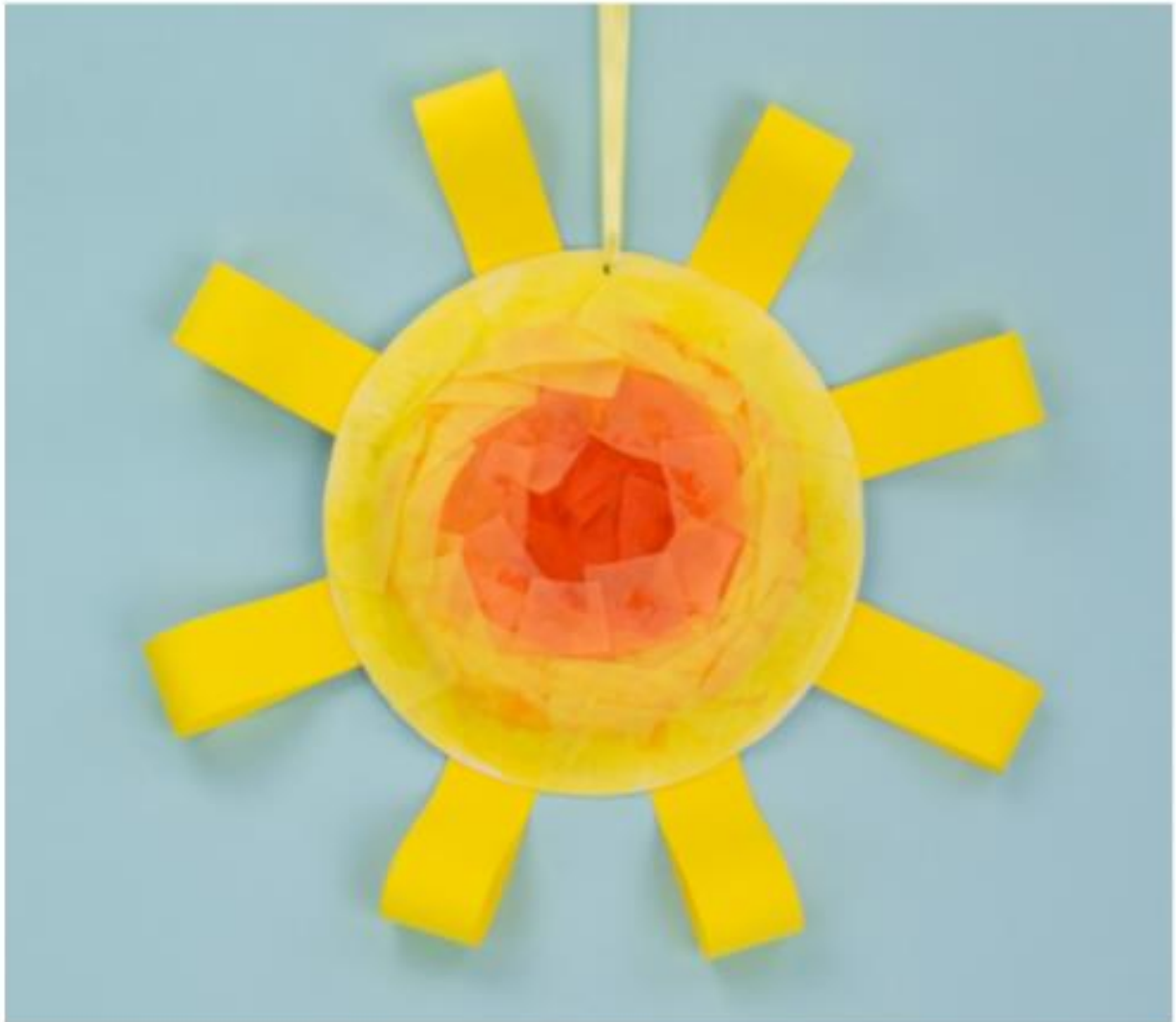

# Paper Plate Sun



## Supplies

- Yellow and orange tissue paper, cut up into squares
- Yellow wool or ribbon
- Yellow paper
- One paper plate
- PVA glue
- Sticky tape
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Pencil





**Step 1.** Spread PVA glue thinly all over the paper plate. Then cover the centre of the plate with the squares of orange tissue paper.



**Step 2.** Continue to build up layers of tissue paper, working from the middle out, sticking them down with glue. Also stick lighter shades of orange, then yellow to make a gradual change to yellow.



**Step 3.** Place the yellow paper landscape, then use a ruler and pencil to draw lines going horizontally along it. Draw the lines from the top to the bottom of the paper, using the width of the ruler to separate each line.



**Step 4.** Using scissors, cut along each line; this should leave you with strips of card a ruler width in thickness.





**Step 5.** Make a loop out of each yellow strip by gluing the ends together.



**Step 6.** Using sticky tape or glue, stick the loops of yellow paper at equal distances around the edge of the paper plate.



**Step 7.** Use a hole punch to make a hole at the edge of the bowl, between two loops.



**Step 8.** Thread a loop of yellow ribbon or wool through the hole and tie so that the sunshine can be hung.
