

Cognition and Learning

Students will engage in play-based learning to develop sensory awareness. They will explore auditory sounds in their environment, such as peer interactions, ICT sounds, and background acoustics. Students will enhance mental well-being, self-esteem, and emotional awareness by pursuing interests, trying new activities, and building resilience. They will develop cooperation, independence, focus, and the ability to follow instructions while engaging with others.
