

Cognition and Learning

This unit uses a play-based approach to build attention, engagement, and confidence in positive interactions with others. Students will explore objects in their environment, express preferences using sensory stimuli, and develop cognitive skills, increasing focus and activity participation to support their PfA and EHCP outcomes. By the end of the unit, students will give focused attention, follow multi-step instructions, confidently try new activities, show independence and resilience, work cooperatively, take turns, form positive relationships, and demonstrate sensitivity to their own and others' needs.

Communication and Interaction

This unit aims to develop effective communication skills using AAC tools, symbols, and multi-sensory strategies tailored to individual needs. Students will express themselves, initiate interactions, engage socially, and participate in learning environments confidently. By the end, they will effectively use communication tools, improve focus, motivation, and autonomy.

Physical and Sensory

This unit helps students develop body awareness through sensory input during physical activities. They will use their senses to improve coordination, movement skills, and confidence.

Social, Emotional and Mental Health

This unit helps students understand and relate to the emotions of others through practical activities using the Interoceptive Curriculum. They will learn to recognise verbal and non-verbal cues, such as body language and sounds, to identify how others may feel. Students will also become more aware of their own emotional and physical needs and develop skills to communicate these effectively. By fostering empathy, kindness, and cooperation, students will build social and emotional skills essential for their well-being, social development, and future success in a diverse world.
