

Cognition and Learning

Students will explore sensory stimuli, express preferences, and develop cognitive skills, supporting their PfA and EHCP outcomes. By the end of the unit, students will demonstrate focused attention, follow multi-step instructions, try new activities with resilience, work cooperatively, build positive relationships, and show sensitivity to their own and others' needs.

Physical and Sensory

Students will learn to accept support for managing behaviour, build positive relationships through interactions, and develop self-regulation skills using targeted strategies to enhance their learning.

Communication and Interaction

This unit focuses on developing students' communication skills using their preferred methods, both in school and within the wider community. By the end of the unit, students will enhance communication and social interactions, develop language skills for making statements, apply communication in daily activities, and actively engage in daily routines.

Social, Emotional and Mental Health

Students will learn about emotions and self-regulation, recognising that feelings vary between individuals. They will apply strategies to manage emotions, understanding their impact on overall well-being, and develop skills to identify and moderate their feelings socially and emotionally.
